- Physical distancing and household bubble requirements will also apply to outings (at restaurants, etc.) as the province is opening up further on Friday, June 5.
- If you do not feel well, it is critically important that you do not go out, and instead follow
 established procedures as stated on NS website to determine what steps you should
 take next.
- With new regulations in place, additional delays/waiting times are to be expected.
 People should be patient.
- Restaurants and other businesses selling alcohol who were offering delivery while NS
 was closed can continue to do so.

(3日) Both cases are in Zone 5. One is linked to a previously identified case in the outbreak, and the other is linked to Manoir de la Vallée, a long-term care facility in Atholville.

A Quebec resident has also tested positive for COVID-19 and is linked to the Atholville long-term care facility. This case will be counted in Quebec's statistics.
