## 【新型コロナ】ニューブランズウィック州の規制緩和発表

## Province will go to Green at midnight on July 30

23 July 2021

Premier Blaine Higgs announced today that the province's mandatory order will <u>not</u> be renewed on July 30 at 11:59 p.m., <u>which will remove all restrictions in the province as it goes to Green</u>.

The end of the mandatory order will:

- Lift all mandatory travel and public health restrictions that have been in place over the course of the pandemic.
- Lift all provincial border restrictions; provincial border checks will cease, and registration will no longer be required to enter New Brunswick from anywhere in Canada.
- Lift all limits on gatherings and the number of people within facilities. Capacity limits in theatres,
  restaurants and stores will no longer be required.
- End the requirement to wear face masks in public.

It is important to note that federal border restrictions will remain in effect.
