●現在, 一日当たり5000件の検査が可能。現状の検査要請には十分カバーできている。

●必要な機材は短期的には十分確保されているので, 心配は無用。

●今後, 不要不急な地方間の旅行も自粛を要請する(demander)

【3 ニューブランズウィック州】

(1) (19日)現地14時半, ヒッグス州首相は記者会見を行ったところ, 右要旨は以下のとおり。

●Still 11 cases in NB: 7 confirmed, 4 presumptive, 410 tested negative. Still no community spread witnessed

●**State of emergency has been declared by NB** under the Emergency Measures Act

●Public schools, universities, and colleges will remain closed until further notice

●All retail businesses must cease to admit the public but may continue with online or delivery sales (Exceptions: grocery stores, pharmacies, government liquor and cannabis stores, automotive repair businesses post offices, gas stations, hardware stores)

●All food and beverage serving businesses restaurants will only offer takeout and delivery services

- Bars, spas, barber shops, hair salons, nail salons must cease operation
- Construction, fabrication shop, etc. activity is prohibited, unless if not public-facing à can continue to operate but must protect their employees' health and safety.
- Recreational and entertainment facilities (dance studios, gyms, cinemas, tennis courts, etc.) must cease to admit members of the public immediately
- Any premise where people typically gather in large numbers must take all responsible steps to prevent gatherings of more than ten people
- All facilities that remain open will reduce to critical function and will take every reasonable steps required to prevent people who present COVID-19 symptoms and people who have traveled internationally without having completed a 14-day quarantine to enter the workplace, to ensure that employees at work have not been exposed to the virus and ensure their compliance with self-isolation if they have been exposed.
- Any person who has travelled outside the country and was advised by a physician to self-isolate should do so; by law they must comply
- Non-essential workers must stay home (except when absolutely necessary like for grocery shopping, going to the pharmacy, etc.)
- The authority of landlords to evict tenants for nonpayment suspended through May 31
- Daycare: technical brief planned for tomorrow

【5 プリンセドワードアイランド州】

(1) (19日) 現地13時半, 州主任保健局長が記者会見を行ったところ, 右要旨は以下のとおり。

- Second case is a man in his 40s (Queens County) returning from travel (UK) who self-isolated upon his return, called 811, tested March 16, has mild symptoms, staying home.
- An online self-assessment tool will be available starting later today to help alleviate pressures on 811 line.
- Patients coming into hospital with flu-like symptoms will be tested for COVID-19 going forward, regardless of travel history.
- Looking at drive-thru testing or sending community paramedics safely into homes to test those in need.
- Government-owned liquor stores will close at 2 p.m. (ADT) today (March 19), but are considering pick-up, delivery, and drive-thru options.
- Agency liquor stores (at convenience stores, gas stations) and breweries remain open.
- If no measures are taken, death toll in PEI could rise to 3000, which is why these measures are so important now, even with only 2 cases confirmed.
- Health PEI facilities' visitations stopped (a few exceptions allow 1 designated visitor from immediate family only), for details: <https://www.princeedwardisland.ca/en/alert/new-visitor-restrictions-added-health-pei-facilities>
- Conserving supplies for essential health-care workers. There are enough swabs and protective equipment for screenings.
- Dialysis, chemotherapy, treatment for heart attacks and emergency services still available.
- Repeated that currently 19 ventilators split between 15 at QEH, and 4 at PCH.

- Still only 1 confirmed case. 183 tests done so far.
- Learning that the virus lives on surfaces from hours to days.
- Asking to stay home whenever possible, limit outings, send only 1 family member to get essentials (e.g. Groceries). Maintain social distancing (2m)
- **Grocery stores (and businesses part of the food supply chain), pharmacies, gas stations, and hardware stores are considered essential and will remain open.**

- Automobile dealers with repair and maintenance services may remain open for maintenance and repair.
- Agency liquor stores (not government-owned), such as convenience stores and breweries, remain open.
- Government-owned liquor stores are reassessing how they can continue to provide services instead of closing completely.
- Places in childcare centres will be maintained, staff will be eligible for employment insurance, and centres will still obtain grants and subsidies.
- Essential (healthcare) workers can use online form (**as soon as possible and no later than Friday, March 20, 2020.**) for their needs to find childcare: <https://www.princeedwardisland.ca/en/service/emergency-child-care-services>

- Encourage people to use the COVID-19 website. It's updated several times every day.
- Gatherings of over 50 people are prohibited
- Such as Gyms, theatres, arenas, tennis, squad, bars are ordered to close
- Pay attention with social distancing. Social distancing are important for all the people, such as people of self-isolation, children etc.
- Children should not have sleepover or playdate during this period.
- Have enough test kits in NL. People who want to get tested can be tested.
