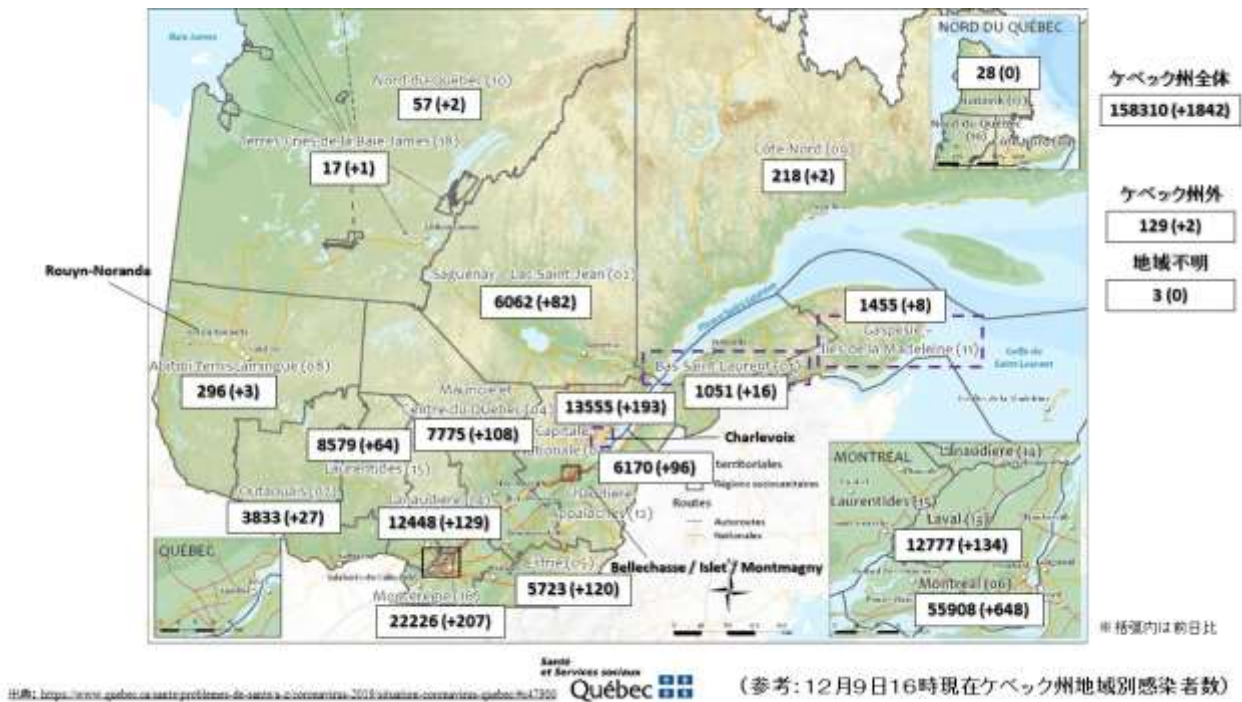

Zone 2 (Saint John region) will move to the Yellow level effective at midnight tonight.

COVID-19 vaccine planning

A detailed vaccine plan for New Brunswick is being developed, and priority groups who will receive the vaccine first have been determined.

These groups include:

- long-term care residents and staff;
- staff from Provincial Rapid Outbreak Management Teams who respond to COVID-19 outbreaks;
- Extra-Mural/Ambulance New Brunswick staff;
- health-care workers;
- First Nations nurses; and
- seniors 85 or older.

“We expect the first 1,950 doses of the Pfizer vaccine to arrive in New Brunswick next week,” said Greg MacCallum, director of the New Brunswick Emergency Measures Organization. “In a province of more than 700,000 people, a total of 1,950 doses is a small number, but it is the first step in a program of regular deliveries going forward. We need people to understand that it will take much of 2021 to roll out and administer vaccine to all New Brunswickers, and to all Canadians.”

N.L. to have first COVID-19 vaccines next week after successful trial shipment

Newfoundland and Labrador moved another step closer in COVID-19 vaccine preparation as Health Minister John Haggie says the thermal shipper — used to keep doses at a consistent temperature during transport — arrived Wednesday morning.

"The dummy cargo was kept appropriately cold and the system works," said Haggie during Wednesday's COVID-19 briefing.

"This now means we are poised, having received Health Canada's approval to use the vaccine, to have our first deliveries next week."
