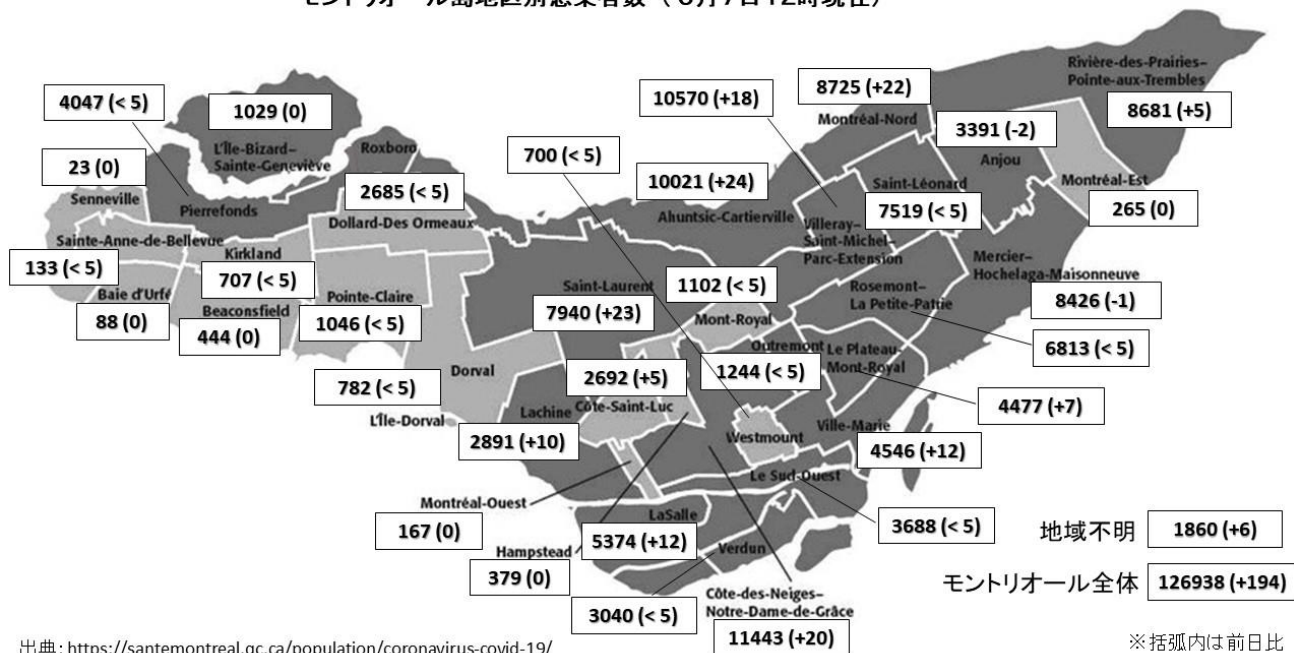

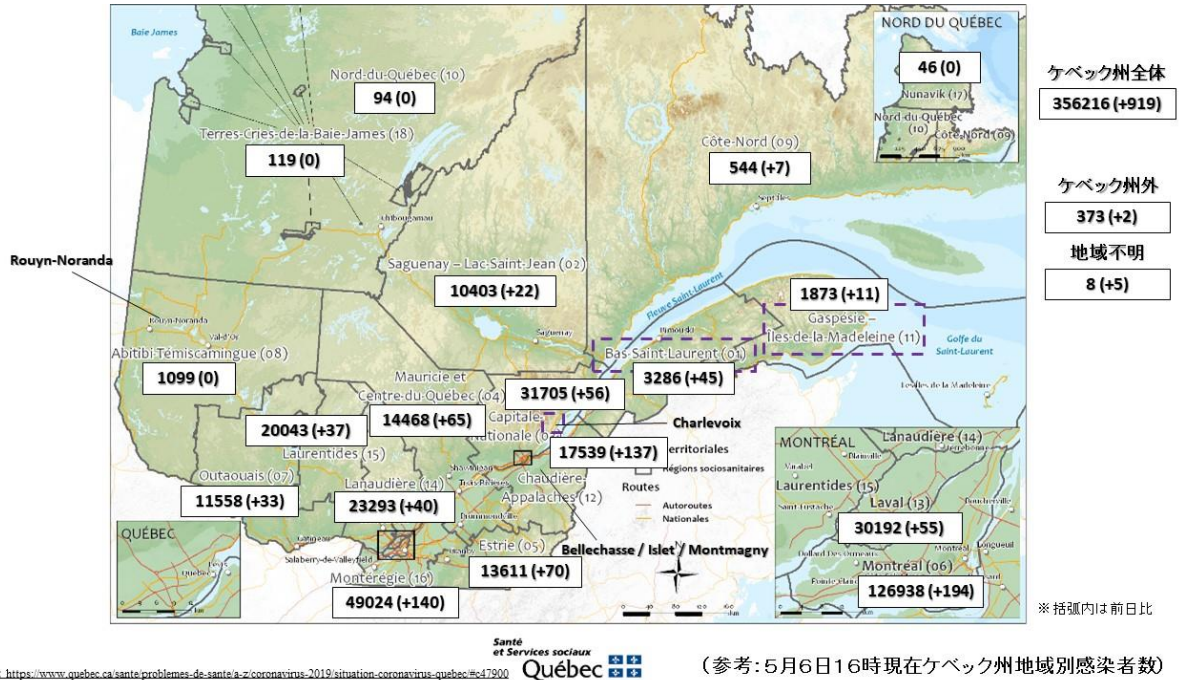

Border and Other Restrictions to Reduce Spread of COVID-19

The measures include extended school closures, tighter border restrictions and isolation requirements for rotational workers, and limits on shoppers. Public and private schools will remain closed to students and at-home learning will continue until at least the end of May. New border measures will take effect at 8 a.m. on Monday, May 10, and will be in place until at least the end of the month:

- Nova Scotia's border will close to people intending to move here
- the border will close to people coming from Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland and Labrador; it was closed previously to non-essential travel from other provinces

Effective at 8 a.m. on Saturday, May 8, Nova Scotians will have to designate one shopper per household and retail stores that offer in-person shopping will impose a limit of one shopper per household.
