

Multiple-entry visa for Chinese citizens residing in Canada

Multiple-entry visas may be issued to applicants with a substantially high income or a sufficient level of financial capability and their families. Visas for the applicants with a substantially high income are valid for 5 years and the period of stay allowed for each visit is up to 90 days. Visas for applicants with a sufficient level of financial capability are valid for 3 years and the period of stay allowed for each visit is up to 30 days.

Requirements:

1. [Visa application form \(PDF\)](#)
2. One photo (2 in x 2 in; Canadian passport size is also acceptable)
3. A passport and a photocopy of this passport (with your personal information and picture)
4. Proof of your status in Canada (the original of your Permanent Resident Card, Work Visa, Student's Visa, etc.) and a photocopy (both sides) of the same document
5. Initial visit requirements:
 - [Schedule of Stay \(PDF\)](#)
 - Confirmation of your airline tickets' reservations or flight itinerary
 - Confirmation of your hotel's reservation
6. Letter explaining the reason why a multiple-entry visa is needed
7. Canadian Bank Statements for the last 6 months
8. Tax assessment issued by the CRA showing total income or T4
9. Proof of employment or enrollment in school
10. Family members (if applicable): Proof of the close family relationship with the income provider (e.g. marriage certificate, birth certificate)

Notes:

- Please do NOT staple or clip the documents.
- All documents must be originals and written in English or French.
- Additional materials may be requested as necessary.
