Multiple-entry visa for citizens of the Philippines, Vietnam and Indonesia Residing in QC, NB, NS, PEI or NL in Canada

Updated: February 2, 2024

Multiple-entry temporary visitor visas may be granted to eligible citizens of the Philippines, Vietnam and Indonesia residing in Canada. The validity is up to 5 years, allowing a period of stay of 15 or 30 days per visit. Please note that temporary visitor visa holders **may not** engage in work or other remunerated activities in Japan.

Application documents

- 1) <u>Visa application form</u> (Example)
 - ☼ Do not leave any field blank. If a field does not apply, write "N/A".
- 2) One photo (35 mm × 45 mm; Canadian passport size is also acceptable)
- 3) A passport and a photocopy of this passport (page with your personal information and signature)
- 4) Proof of your status in Canada (the original of your Permanent Resident Card, Work Visa, Student's Visa, etc.) and a photocopy (both sides) of the same document
- 5) Confirmation of your airline tickets' reservations or flight itinerary
- 6) Confirmation of your hotel's reservation or planned itinerary
- 7) Schedule of stay (Example)
- 8) Letter explaining the reason for requesting a multiple-entry visa (dated and signed)

AND documents for **ONE** of the following categories.

- (1) Applicant with travel record to Japan as a "temporary visitor" in the last three years and sufficient financial stability for travel
 - Passport (or old passport) containing Japanese visa and landing permission stamp and a photocopy
 - Latest Canadian bank statement, showing sufficient funds to travel
 - Tax assessment issued by the CRA showing total income or T4
 - Employment letter

- (2) Applicant with travel records as a "temporary visitor" to Japan and G7 countries in the last three years
 - Passport (or old passport) containing Japanese visa and landing permission stamp and a photocopy
 - Passport (or old passport) containing visa and landing permission stamp for G7 countries (other than Japan) and a photocopy
 - Employment letter

(3) Employed individuals with sufficient financial capacity

- Tax assessment issued by the CRA showing total income or T4
- Canadian bank statements for the last 6 months
- Employment letter

FOR FAMILY MEMBERS

(4) Spouse or child of an individual eligible under category (3) **ONLY**

- Document(s) to prove kinship (marriage certificate, birth certificate, etc.)
- If applying separately from the individual eligible under category (3):
 - Tax assessment issued by the CRA showing total income or T4 of that individual
 - Canadian bank statements of that individual for the last 6 months
 - Employment letter of that individual
